## *Mermaid White Wines by the Glass*

### *Garganega "Ancora" 2017 (Italy) ABV 12.5%*

This dry white has aromas of golden delicious apples and sweet spice. The palate is clean and crisp, yet with texture and weight. Includes notes of apricot, flowers, ginger and honey with a lemony finish.

### *Chardonnay "Domaine des Pourthié" 2016 (France) ABV 13%*

Delightfully fresh, this dry white from the Languedoc region is artfully balanced. With rich buttery notes and subtle oak, complemented by fresh aromas of the wild herbs that typically grow in the clay & limestone soil of the Vineyard, which thrives on a ridge formed during the Ice Age.

1. *Garganega “Ancora” 2017 (Italy) ABV 13%*

This dry white has aromas of golden delicious apples and sweet spice. The palate is clean and crisp, yet with texture and weight. Includes notes of apricot, flowers, ginger and honey with a lemony finish.

11. *Malvasia “Vina Kozlović”, Istria 2016 (Croatia) ABV 12%*

A bright, transparent, green-yellow colour. Intense aroma with many layers. A profound scent of peach followed by refined herbal notes. On the palate, nectarine, melon and red apples. The finish gives way to a light nuttiness. The Kozlović family invite you to sample the fruits of their labour.

5. *Rey Santo Verdejo, Javier Sanz, Rueda 2016 (Spain)*  
*ABV 13%*

A clean, fresh, bright wine full of vibrant aromas of pineapple, kiwi, passionfruit combined with a wet stone mineral complexity. Rich and well-structured with a pure persistent finish.

14. *Grüner Veltliner “Langenlois”, Weingut Rabl, Kamptal 2014 (Austria) 2017 ABV 12.5%*

A spicy opening with yellow apple, wood apple, soft honeydew melon, a well-defined body with good fleshiness, juicy cascading acidity - a dynamic palate with a savoury peppery spicy finish.

15. *Gavi di Gavi, San Silvestro, “Fossili” (Italy) 2016 ABV 12.5%*

A crisp wine which shows incredible minerality, zesty citrus and floral notes with a hint of spice and the typical touch of bitter almond that makes this wine unique. Prominent mineral characters with appealing green apple linger on the long and precise finish.

8. *Picpoul de Pinet, “Tournée du Sud” 2016 (France) ABV 12.5%*

The literal translation of Picpoul is ‘lip-stinger’ because of its freshness. A Mediterranean white with all the salty, lemony, floral finesse of the zippy picpoul grape. Slightly steely and lemony on the nose with an unusual depth on the palate which finishes with a long refreshing taste which is fantastic with seafood.

6. *Pinot Grigio "Villa Molino" 2016 (Italy) ABV 12%*

Straw yellow in colour with golden hues. A delicate bouquet on the nose with a stony palate. Fresh & well balanced with good acidity. A quality Pinot Grigio from its heartland in Veneto.

13. *Quincy, Beaucharme, "Domaine Sylvain Bailly" 2013 (France) ABV 12.5%*

Sancerre's neighbour, same region, same soil but in our eyes - a superior quality wine! Hosting striking notes of green gooseberry, mineral elegance with lots of expansive length. For someone who enjoys Sancerre, we promise you will be pleasantly surprised! A wine coming from the second oldest appellation in France.

17. *Riesling, 'Fox Run Vineyards' 2015 (USA, New York) ABV 11.5%*

Intensely perfumed with an aroma of slate, lime peel & kiwi balanced beautifully with a mineral background and bold acidity with a great persistence. A perfect wine for Asian style dishes especially fish & shellfish. A rich complex wine with fruits and zest. Fox Run Vineyards are located next to the Glacier Finger Lakes, world renowned for its Trout fishing.

18. *Koshu Kayagatake, 'Grace Winery' 2016 (Japan, Yamanashi) ABV 11.5%*

Flavours of salty sapphire & wet stone combined with a thirst-quenching acidity, with a fresh lemon & grapefruit nose. A perfect wine with sashimi or any ocean ingredients. Koshu is Japan's indigenous vitis vinifera white grape which has been growing in Japan for over 1000 years. Grown on the foot of Mt. Kayagatake with long sunshine and cool climate.

**16. Meursault 1er Cru “Les Charmes-Dessus” Vincent Girardin 2005 (France) ABV 13.5%**

The sixty-five-year-old vines are located in the village of Meursault, in the south of the Cote De Beaune on low slopes of clay and limestone offering a Southeast exposure. The Chardonnay grapes are harvested by hand and lightly pressed at a low pressure to allow a slow extraction. The wine is transferred to French oak casks to ferment with wild yeast for a minimum of 16 months. Honey and toasted bread aromas. Elegant and strong structure on the palate. This wine is made with care and a lot of pride and excels when matched with fish or poultry.

**2. Sauvignon Blanc/Carmenère “Maule Valley” 2016 (Chile) ABV 12.5%**

Citrus and tropical aromas along with subtle mineral notes from the 90% Sauvignon Blanc intermingle attractively with the herbal notes and soft spicy aromas from the 10% red grape Carmenere. Beautifully balanced with a fruity finish.

**4. Chardonnay “Domaine des Pourthié” 2016 (France) ABV 13%**

10. *“Guindalera”, Moscatel de Alexandria, Calvente 2015 (Spain)*  
*ABV 13% Wine Exclusive to The Mermaid*

An exceptional dry Muscat with aromas of peach, grapefruit, pineapple and Orange Blossom with an elegant, fresh palate. This was one of the few Spanish wines make the prestigious guide “1001 Wines to try before you Die”. The grapes are grown and hand-picked from the hamlet of La Guindalera and brought down from the Granada mountains by mule. They say the secret is in the vines – up to 120 years old.

**19. *Ríoja “Rívallana” 2015 (Spain) ABV 13%***

An intense oak aged Rioja with deep flavours of cherries, plums and vanilla. Aged in French & American oak barrels for a year before bottling.

**45. *Cabernet Franc “Trapiche” 2016 (Argentina) ABV 14%***

This full bodied powerful fruity wine is a taste to experience. Strong aromas of black fruits and red bell pepper with spicy notes. With soft tannins and a long lasting finish, this wine is beautifully balanced. In 1883, Trapiche was the first winery in Argentina with a train station to allow wine barrels to be easily loaded for quick distribution to the global market.

**53. *Syrah Gran Reserva, Vina Echeverria, Aconcagua 2014 (Chile) ABV 14.5%***

A bold wine with a dark chocolate and cigar box character. It is extremely smooth and silky. A very elegant & mature wine with hints of mint & coffee. An incredible wine, you will not be disappointed.

**99. *Corbières, ‘Chateau Haut Gléon’ 2009 (France) ABV 14%***

The perfect wine to accompany steak. This wine, set in the heart of the Corbières region, Château Haut Gléon is a deep garnet red. Hosting an intense, complex bouquet with black fruit, mild spices and roasted coffee bean hints. Full and rounded on the palate with mellow tannins. A long, fresh finish. This red Corbières is made with Syrah, Grenache and Carignan grapes.

**43. Cahors Malbec "Knom" Clos Troteligotte 2016 (France) ABV 12.5%**

Emmanuel Rybinski brings us this passionate, dynamic red from the birthplace of Malbec; yet adds a modern twist with a touch of Merlot. It has a concentrated blackcurrant scent, intriguing undertones of crystallised pineapple which persist through the palate with soft, fine tannins.

**56. Borsao, Campo de Borja, Aragon 2016 (Spain) ABV 14.5%**

A fantastic wine with a deep cherry colour, intense and vivid. It possesses a powerful nose of ripe red fruits and hints of new oak. Full bodied and richly flavoured, very well balanced with a persistent long spicy finish. Robert Parker in *Wine Advocate* wrote: "Bodegas Borsao has long been known for its high quality, value-priced wines and the current releases are no exception".

**26. Grand Merlot dal Pic, Collavini 2011 (Italy) ABV 13.5%**

A Merlot to stand above all others! This complex deep ruby wine hosts intense concentrated fragrances of forest fruits, spices and liquorice. A rich, fruit-led weave on the palate fuses with the warmth and softness of a great wine. Velvety tannins enhance and support the persistence of the after-aroma.

**30. Pomerol 'Chateau Beauregard' 2013 (France) ABV 13.5%**

Pomerol is regarded as one of the top five wines in the world. A very bold but silky wine with intense juicy black fruits on the nose with a long-lasting finish accompanied by a hint of dryness. An exceptional wine hosts a complexity of leather and spice with finely edged tannin. Perfectly balanced that will certainly live up to expectations.

### 21. *Malbec “Sierra Los Andes” 2016 (Mendoza, Argentina)*

*ABV 14%*

On the nose, it shows intense spicy and sweet aromas together with red fruit notes and floral violet hints. With a soft, velvety and very well balanced fresh finish. Beautiful with red meats or pasta.

### 40. *Primitivo Di Manduria 2013 (Italy) ABV 14%*

A wonderfully balanced red, with poise and refinement despite its full-bodied style. Aged in French and American barrels for six months. It has an intense bouquet of dark berry fruits, with blackcurrants, blackberries and black cherries bursting through on the palate. Perfect with lamb and game with rich sauces.

### 44. *Petite Sirah “Lot 96”, Foppiano Vineyards, Russian River Valley, Sonoma County 2014 (California, USA) ABV 14.5% 2013*

A grape also known as Durif (in Australia). Deeply coloured shades of red and purple. Hosting notes of blackberry, black cherry and black pepper with a deep vivacious feel. Soft tannin and a very juicy, long finish.

50. ***Rasteau, Domaine Bressy Masson 2015 (France) ABV 14.5%***  
With 80% Grenache & 20% Syrah this wine packs a warmth of juicy red fruits with a hint of spice that will leave you salivating for another glass. A strong blackberry nose with a touch of black pepper. A powerful wine with depth and roundness. Very clean, complex & well balanced.

51. ***Durif, Winemakers Reserve, Berton Vineyard 2016 (Australia) ABV 14.5%***  
Intense aromas of violets & blackberry with a palate of anise, smoke, spicy oak & liquorice. A deep, almost inky colour hosting a wine full of depth and dark fruits. A very good steak wine with chimichurri.

47. ***Goru, 'Bodegas Juan Gil' 2016 (Spain) ABV 15%***  
A fantastic blend of Monastrell, Syrah & Petit Verdot. Hosting wonderful depth of flavour with a wild bottle. Very well balanced with juicy dark fruits and a good tannin.

The story goes, this wine was named after a wild, friendly and admired character called Goru, who lived in the forest. He was known for his capacity of seduction and extreme generosity for spreading his love. Remembered with affection for generations and immortalised in numerous paintings, one of which is displayed on the bottle. A wine with a story to tell.....

## *Oaked, Smoked & Peppery*

20. *Nero d'Avola "Vitese" 2016 (Sicily) ABV 14%*  
A brilliant, deep red with juicy flavours of ripe plum and black cherries interlaced with subtle violet notes. Concentrated on the palate are deep fruit flavours backed by soft, ripe tannins and a spicy character to finish.

41. *Carmenère Reserva 'Valle de Colchagua' 2016 (Chile) ABV 13.5%*  
Deep dark aromas of red fruits, peppery spices & juicy berries. Has soft and gentle tannins with an elegant but vibrant acidity.

23. *Tempranillo Reserva "Castillo de Manzanares" 2010 (Spain) ABV 13.5%*  
Aged for over 3 years in oak barrels and bottle resulting in a luscious intense red. Rich in fruit aromas with a lingering, slightly spicy finish. A bin end so we are able to offer it at a very reduced price. Drinking deliciously.

42. *Pinotage "Olifantsberg" 2016 (South Africa) ABV 13%*  
Medium-bodied with a fresh berry nose with a hint of smoke. A very well-balanced and smooth palate complemented by a sweet spice to go well with a fusion of spiced food.

49. *Côte de Bergerac "Château de Peytirat" 2015 ABV 12.5%*  
*Wine Exclusive to The Mermaid*  
A silky smooth wine with hints of blackberries, raspberries and stone fruit, from Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. The strength effortlessly compliments duck, red meats and is also great with strong cheeses.

60. *Pinotage "Barista" 2017 South Africa ABV 13%*

A burst of intense rich coffee and chocolate aromas with ripe nuances of mulberry, plum & Maraschino cherries. Winemaker Bertus Fourie has been given the nickname 'Starbucks' after his pursuit in creating the world's first Coffee Pinotage. He has concentrated on drawing out the coffee like aromas by toasting French oak at different temperatures to yield unique aromatics in the oak, obtaining what he calls, a specific toasting 'profile'.

52. *Rioja Reserva "Ondarre" 2014 (Spain) ABV 14%*

Bright ruby-red in colour, a gentle sweet cherry & raspberry flavour with hints of cedar oak & minerals. Finishes with a bright, tangy edge, soft tannins and a hint of zesty white pepper.

46. *Grand Malbec "Piattelli" 2015 (Argentina) ABV 14.5%*

A rich and fragrant wine which represents the best of their crop. An intense red with aromas of strong black fruits, vanilla oak, and a touch of smoke. These aromas are transferred on the palate to give the wine superb structure with a full body that doesn't disappoint. A soft fruit-forward flavour leads to a strong and well balanced finish. You will be left wanting more.

27. *The Butler Blend, Single Vineyard Cuvee 2012 (California, USA) ABV 15%*

This biodynamic expression of the unique Butler Ranch is a Rhone style-based blend. Leading with deep, blackberry and mulberry aromas, a touch of leather, smoke and aged cedar. Fantastically complex but not challenging. The palate hosts rich blackberry jam, briar fruits & black pepper all concluding with a velvety-smooth long finish.

29. *Chateau Musar 2000 (Lebanon) ABV 14%*

The character is dense, richly-textured, with intense 'baked fruit' flavours of plums, damsons, cranberries, fig and dates.

The Hochar family produce this wonderful wine from their winery in Ghazir, 15 miles north of the capital, Beirut. The founder, Serge Hochar's sons manage the day to day running of the winery. Marc explains "My brother looks after the liquid. I look after the liquidity" The Musar grapes are grown in sunny Bekaa Valley at an altitude of 3000 ft all waiting to be hand- harvested.

22. *Pinot Noir "Esprit De Montaigu" 2015 (France) ABV 12.5%*

Delectable on the palate with fruit and chocolate flavours. Aromas of soft red fruits with a beautiful light ruby colour.

48. *Madiran 'Chateau Fitere' 2010 (France) ABV 14%*

Carries an abundance of depth and complexity with great concentration. It impresses with the intensity of the bouquet, and the immense ageing potential. The combination of ripe red fruits, gunflint, and smoky notes creates a lovely balance. To the palate its very chewy texture along with pleasant freshness supported by strong, wooded tannins.

### *Muscat de St-Jean-de Minervois 2012, Petit Grain (France) ABV 15%*

Boasting the ripest bunch of raisined grapes squeezed into your glass from Languedoc-Roussillon! Deliciously honied and fruit, rather than sugar-sweet so not cloying - with a kick of lemony freshness.

### *Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc, Echeverria 2011 ABV 13.5%*

Complex nose with clear overtones of mature peaches, apricots and honey, with a delicate background of botrytis. Rich, intense and full bodied, with a long and elegant finish where fruits and botrytis express their identity in full harmony.

### *Quady Muscat "Elysium" 2015 (California) ABV 15%*

Elysium is Greek for 'Perfect Bliss', so fitting for this excellent wine. Virtually black in colour with intense rose aroma. This wine can stand up to chocolate dishes or is wonderful drizzled over ice cream.

***Tokaj, Noble Late Harvest, Katinka (Hungary) 2013 ABV 12%***

Light golden straw colour, medium bodied, reflecting its 12 months in barriques with appealing vanilla and caramel notes. Lightly sweet showing dried orange, tobacco and white chocolate on a light spicy background. Perfect balance of complexity & elegance.

***Sauternes, Grand Vin de Bordeaux, Dulong Reserve (France) ABV 13%***

The Dulong family have been hand-harvesting their grapes since 1873. This luscious dessert wine has an explosion of crystallised mandarin, apricot jam and citrus. A honey nose, rich and smooth.

***Quady Muscat "Deviation" 2015 (California) ABV 15%***

A dessert wine that stands above all others. This Orange Muscat is infused with Rose Geranium & Damiana which was first used by the Mayans for its aphrodisiac properties. The herbs are steeped in the wine for seven days then matured for 1 year before release, giving the wine a beautiful aromatic essence.

This dessert wine is truly unique and delivers impact with every taste. Its complex fusion-style of aromatic qualities and tastes offer glorious surprises at every turn. For all dessert wine lovers, you must try!

### *Champagne Chimère Brut (France) ABV 12%*

A classic champagne produced from Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier – aged for a minimum of 15 months before release. It has a beautiful aroma of fruity white flowers, flattered with light, delicate bubbles. On the palate it is fresh with biscuity notes and a long, elegant finish.

### *English Sparkling Wine*

#### *Sugrue Pierre, South Downs Brut 2011 (England) ABV 12%*
